

If guests with pets do not follow the rules, they may be asked to leave.

- All pets must be checked in and wear identification while in the building. Staff can help you if your pet does not have an ID on.
- Pets need to be crated while inside at all times and leashed when walking outdoors. Leashes and crates are available to borrow if needed.
- Take your dog out to potty on the grass regularly. Watch their paws on the sidewalk or parking lot, it may be too hot for them!
- Please pick up dog poo using poo bags (available if needed) and throw in outside trash.
- Keep strange pets away from each other.
- Do not allow others to interact with your pet; in strange situations pets are more likely to bite.
- If your pet makes a mess inside the building let us know, cleaning supplies are available!
- If your dog is barking excessively or making noise, you may be asked to move locations or to leave.
- You must stay with your pet at all times. Animals cannot be left on their own unless crated and for very short periods of time to allow for owner breaks.
- Respect "No pets allowed" areas of the building.
