Survey Results

- 94% response rate
- A third of those who responded said their engagement had been impacted by virtual meetings
 - 2/3 of those said the impact had been negative

Meeting Format

- 93% of those who responded said that they would consider attending in person meeting
- No one responded that they wanted to resume in-person only meetings
- Most folks indicated they liked a virtual meetings while the remainder indicated they would like having both virtual and in-person options

Meetings Moving Forward

- We will continue to meet virtually and offer a hybrid (in-person and virtual) meeting quarterly
- Tentatively planning for the first hybrid meeting in November
- We will re-evaluate next summer to see if we want to continue with this process or make any changes

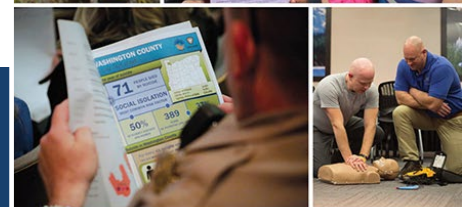
