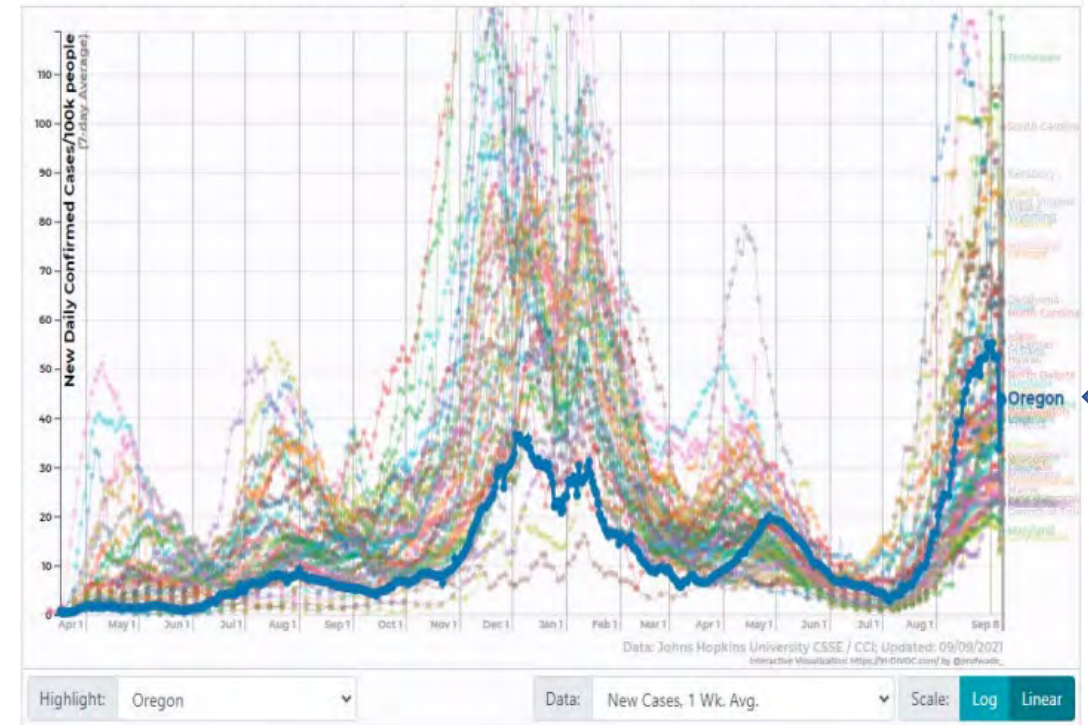
# Oregon Health Science University (OHSU)

## New Cases

- Oregon ranked 24th
  - Down from 18<sup>th</sup>
  - Decline in newly identified cases
- Ratio of unvaccinated to vaccinated is approximately 7:1.

New Confirmed COVID-19 Cases per Day by States/Territories, normalized by population



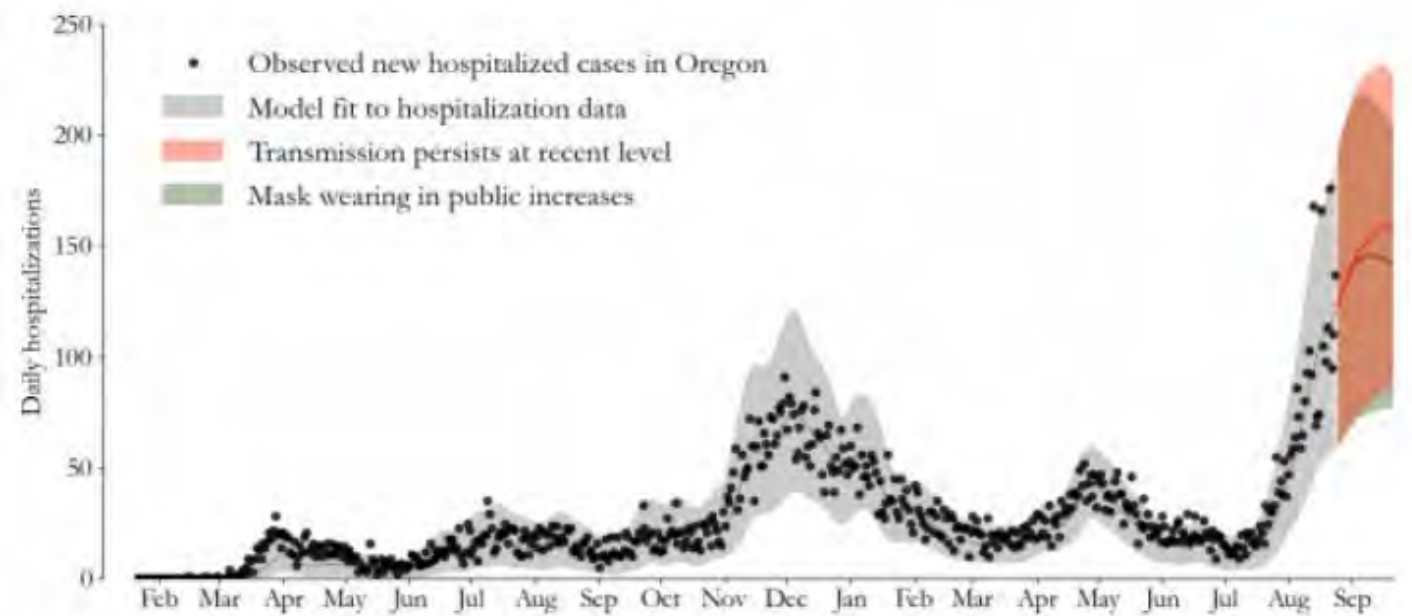

## Hospitalizations

- Forecasted peak
  - Late Sept./Early Oct.
  - Decrease significantly
- Third lowest proportion of beds occupied with COVID
- Eight percent of All Beds (Non-ICU & ICU) available in OR

## Spread

- Lower Reproductive Number
  - Number of individuals each sick person infects

# Summary

- Decreases in cases and spread may be related to:
  - Increases in vaccination
  - Increases in mask wearing
  - Recovery from infection
- Additional weeks of data are needed to determine if Oregon has reached a peak of COVID-19 cases.
- Prevention measures still needed to decrease cases and increase hospital capacity.
