



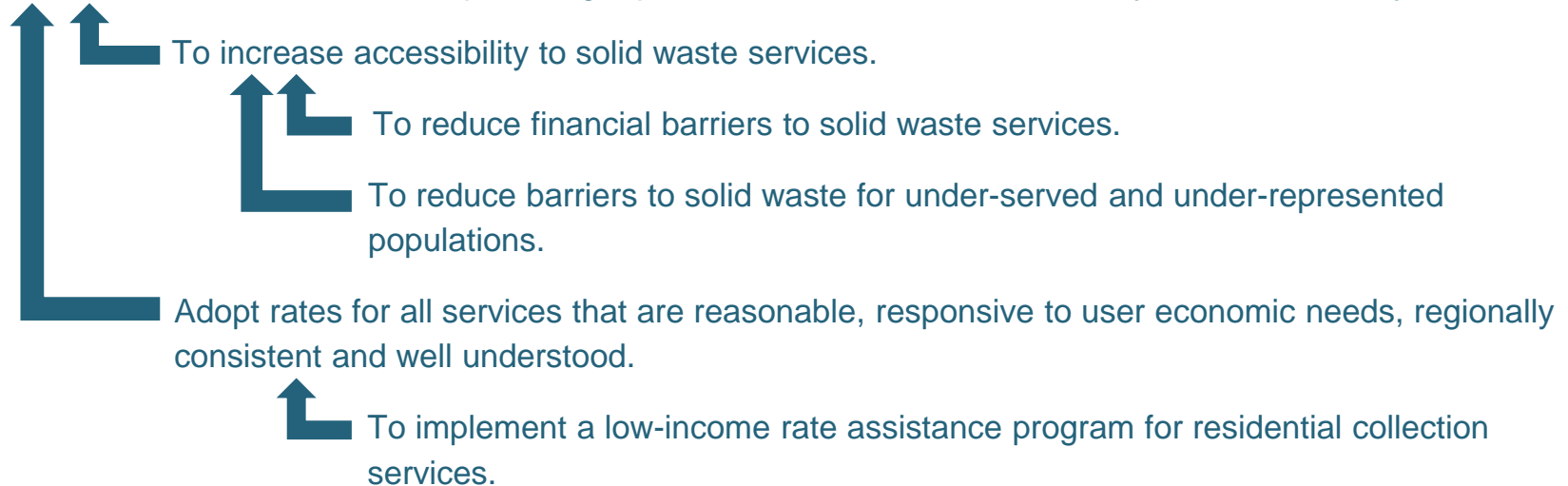
# Washington County Solid Waste Rate Equity Analysis

# Progress To-Date

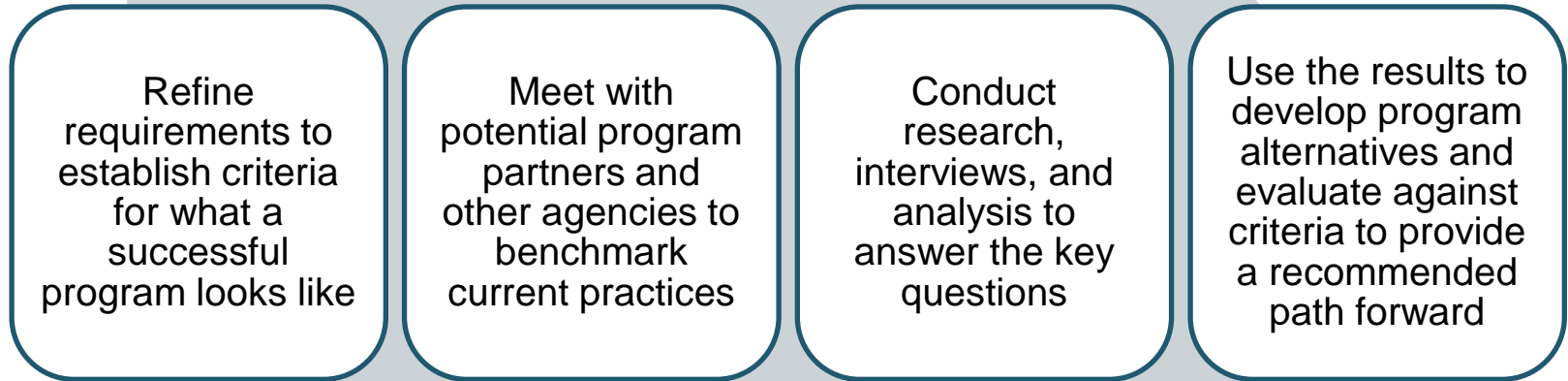
- + Met with Washington County Solid Waste program staff, Community Action, and representatives from the Haulers Association to define the objectives for the project and compile requirements to successfully implement a ***sustainable, equitable, and effective*** solid waste assistance program.
- + Conducted a work session with Washington County Solid Waste program staff to validate what we heard and identify key questions that should be addressed in the development of the program.

# Key Questions

- ? What amount of financial assistance is "enough" to have a positive impact on eligible participants?
- ? What is the appropriate balance between value to the community vs. cost impact to rate payers?
- ? How do we reach the targeted communities and address structural barriers inherent to the current system?
- ? How do we leverage existing and potential future program partners to increase administrative efficiency and optimize outreach to the targeted communities?
- ? How can we model the program to be self-funded within the current solid waste collection system?
- ? What residential collection services should be included? (Basic garbage or to include distance fees, bulky waste pick-up, extra)
