WHAT IS WIC

Short for Women, Infants, and Children (WIC), this program gives families the **services, support, and education** they need to eat right, have a healthy pregnancy, breastfeed successfully, and raise thriving kids.

WHO QUALIFIES

- Pregnant or breastfeeding people
- Infants & kids up to their 5th birthday
- Foster children
- Have lost a pregnancy recently
- Have had a baby in the last six months

*OHP, SNAP, TANF recipients automatically qualify

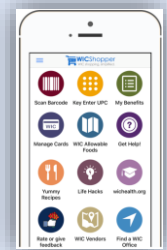
A pregnant person's household is increased by the number of infants they are expecting.
