The safe rest pods are a resource for guests only, not open to all. No RVs or other campers will be allowed to stay on the property. As part of the placement process, participants agree to a Code of Conduct agreement, curfew, and quiet hours.



Supportive Neighborhood Plan

Washington County and Open Door are committed to providing transparent information about the shelter before and after the shelter opens. Shelter staff will provide a proactive, supportive presence in the neighborhood and use a "Supportive Neighborhood Plan" and 24/7 staffing. The pod village will include a dedicated phone number for neighbors to contact if they have questions or concerns about site operations.



Safe Rest Pods provide living space & porch space for each guest

Site amenities will include:

- Guest & staff parking
- Gathering tent
- Smoking & pet spaces
- Restrooms, Showers, & handwashing stations
- Trash disposal
- Installation of perimeter fence & gate for security and privacy

The Washington County Homeless Services Division provides evidence based, trauma informed, and culturally responsive programs designed to advance equity while ending homelessness. Programs include emergency shelter, housing navigation, move-in assistance and wrap-around support services. These programs are funded with federal, state, and local resources, including the Supportive Housing Services measure approved by voters in 2020.
