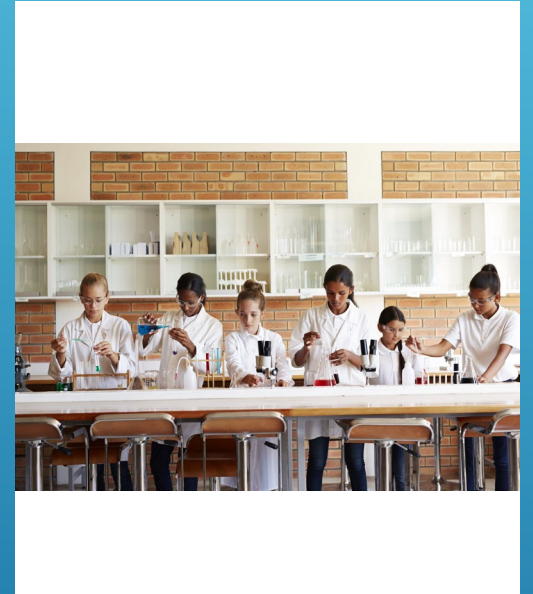

WDD Programs Provide: career-based planning, career-based training, work experiences, and job placement.

Service Area: Clackamas, Multnomah, & Washington Counties

► NextGen

Provides career training and support for Multnomah and Washington Counties youth (17-24). Extensive and enhanced services to clients with on-ramps to employment pathways through training and occupational coaching. Participants also have access to various support services and paid internship through WEX-Y program.

► Connect2Careers

Provides job placement, and academic support for Clackamas County youth aged 14-24. Assists with finding short-term training programs, internships, or job placement support as per the youth's field of interest.

► OYEP

Occupational skills training and paid work experiences for Youth in Multnomah, Washington and Clackamas Counties aged 14-24.

YOUTH WORKFORCE PROGRAMMING



► SummerWorks

Youth that apply for SummerWorks get placed at temporary paid internships with transportation assistance and job-related supports.

Youth can work up to 160 hours.

► WEXY

A year-round paid work experience program similar to SummerWorks where youth are placed in paid internships and receive career coaching support.

Youth can work up to 150 hours.
