

Metro Supportive Housing Services Racial Equity Analysis



Required Elements for the Local Implementation Plan

• Racial equity analysis. An articulation of disparities in housing instability and access to current services, including:

 an analysis of the racial disparities among people experiencing homelessness and the priority service populations.

 an analysis of the racial disparities in access to programs, and housing and services outcomes, for people experiencing homelessness and the priority service populations.



Priority Populations

• 75% of SHS funds will be devoted to services for <u>Population A</u>, defined as:

- Extremely low-income; AND
- Have one or more disabling conditions; AND
- Are experiencing or at imminent risk of experiencing long-term or frequent episodes of literal homelessness.

• 25% of SHS funds will be devoted to services for <u>Population B</u>, defined as:

- Experiencing homelessness; OR
- Have a substantial risk of experiencing homelessness.
