- **530 Adults and Children** (522 adults and children 2018)
 - ❑ Sheltered—298 people, 209 households
(163 people, 112 households in 2018)
 - ❑ Unsheltered—232 people, 207 households
(301 people, 359 households 2018)
 - ❑ Increase number of people self-reporting substance disorder:
 - 127 in 2019
 - 31 in 2018
 - 25 in 2017

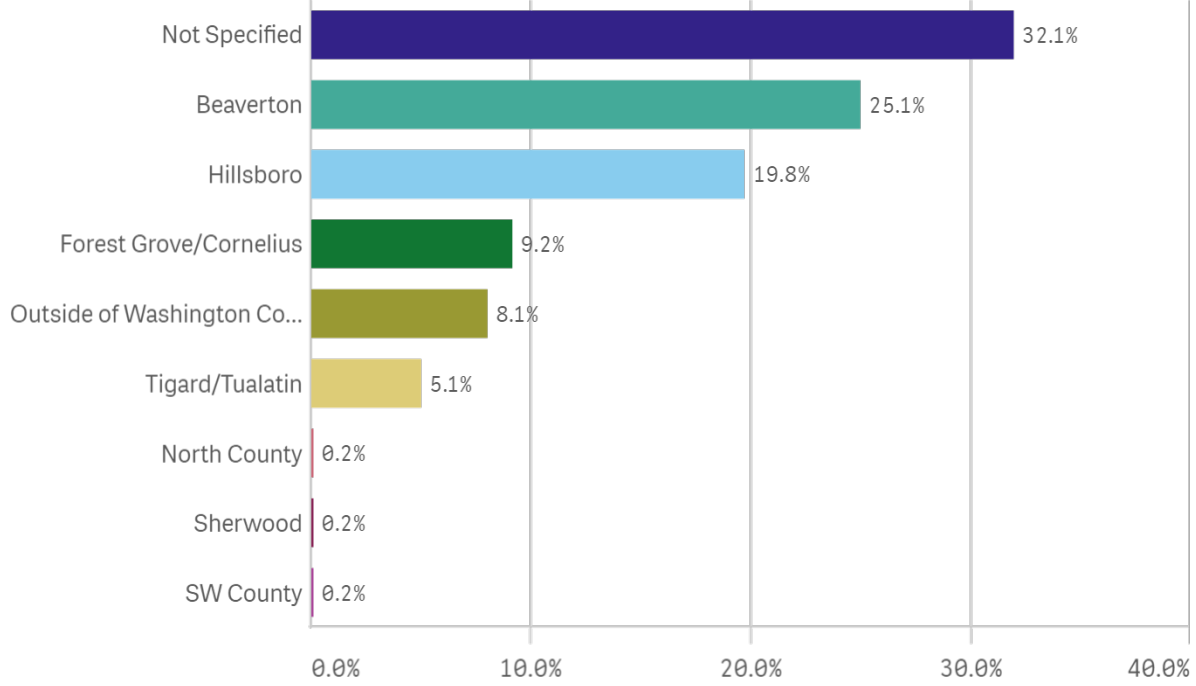

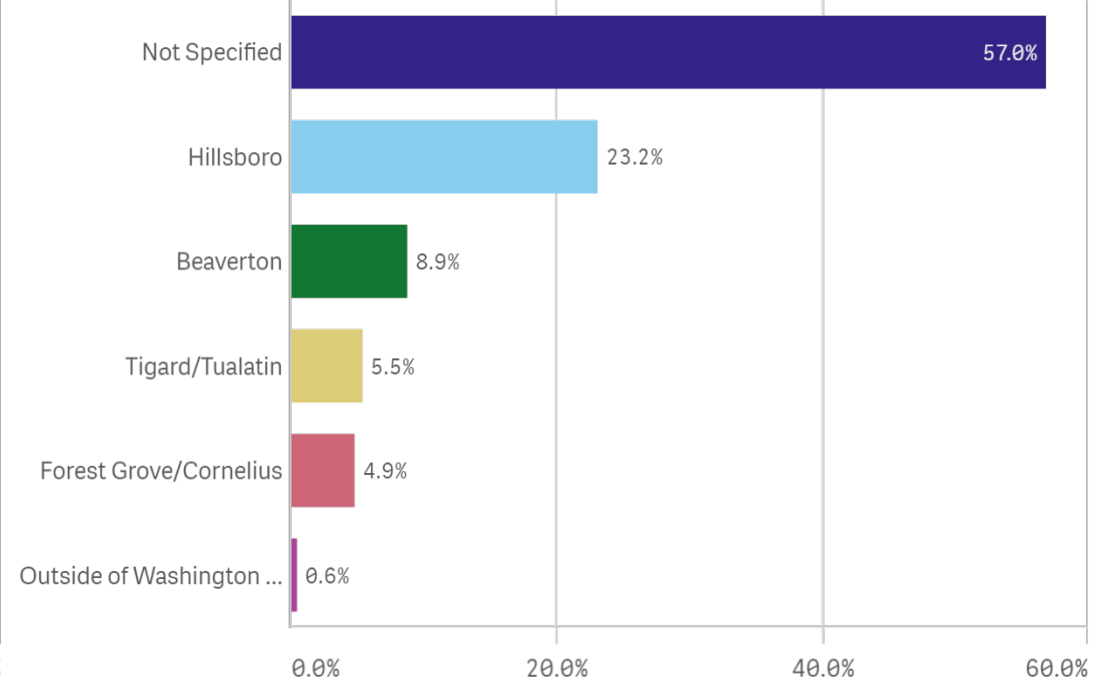

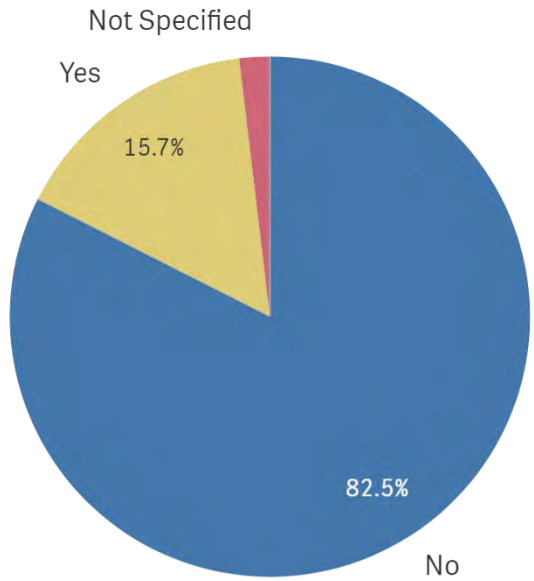
Area in which person usually stays



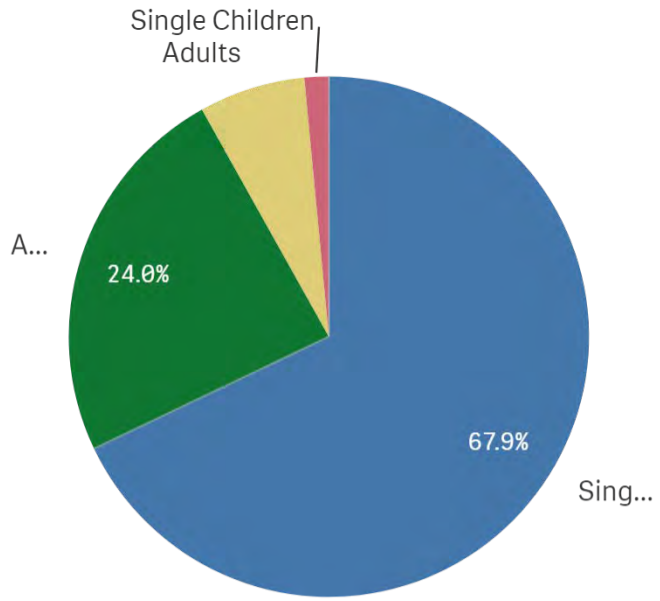
Area in which person was contacted (PIT)



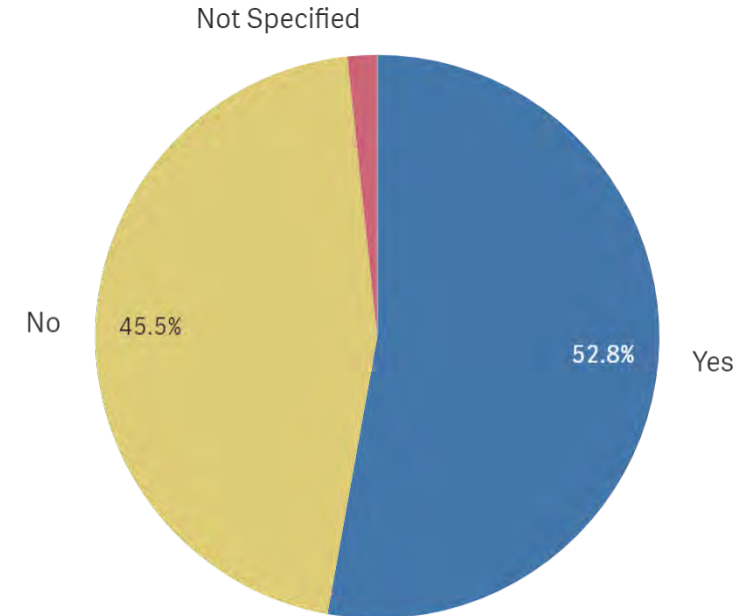
Veteran

Disability Status



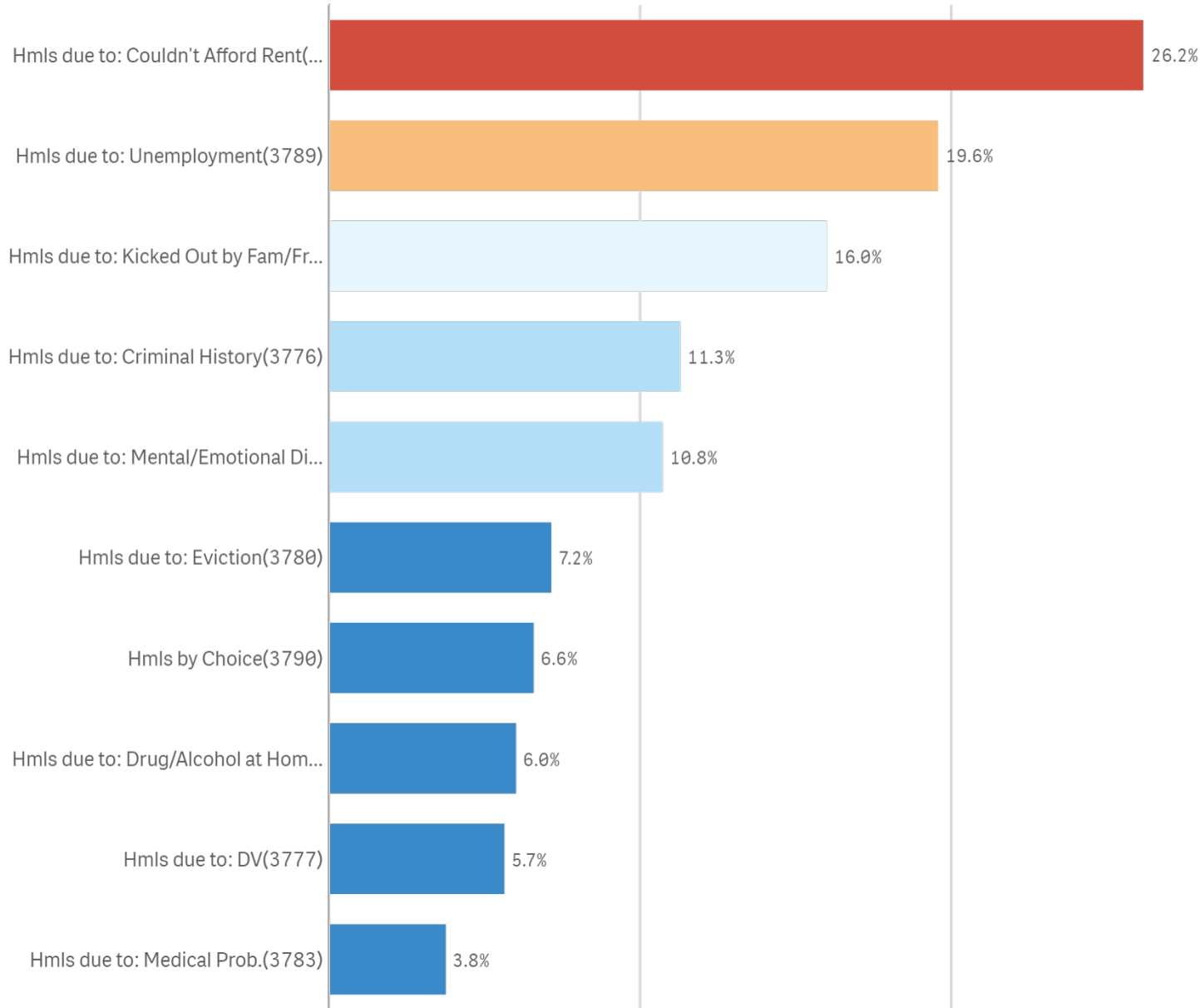
