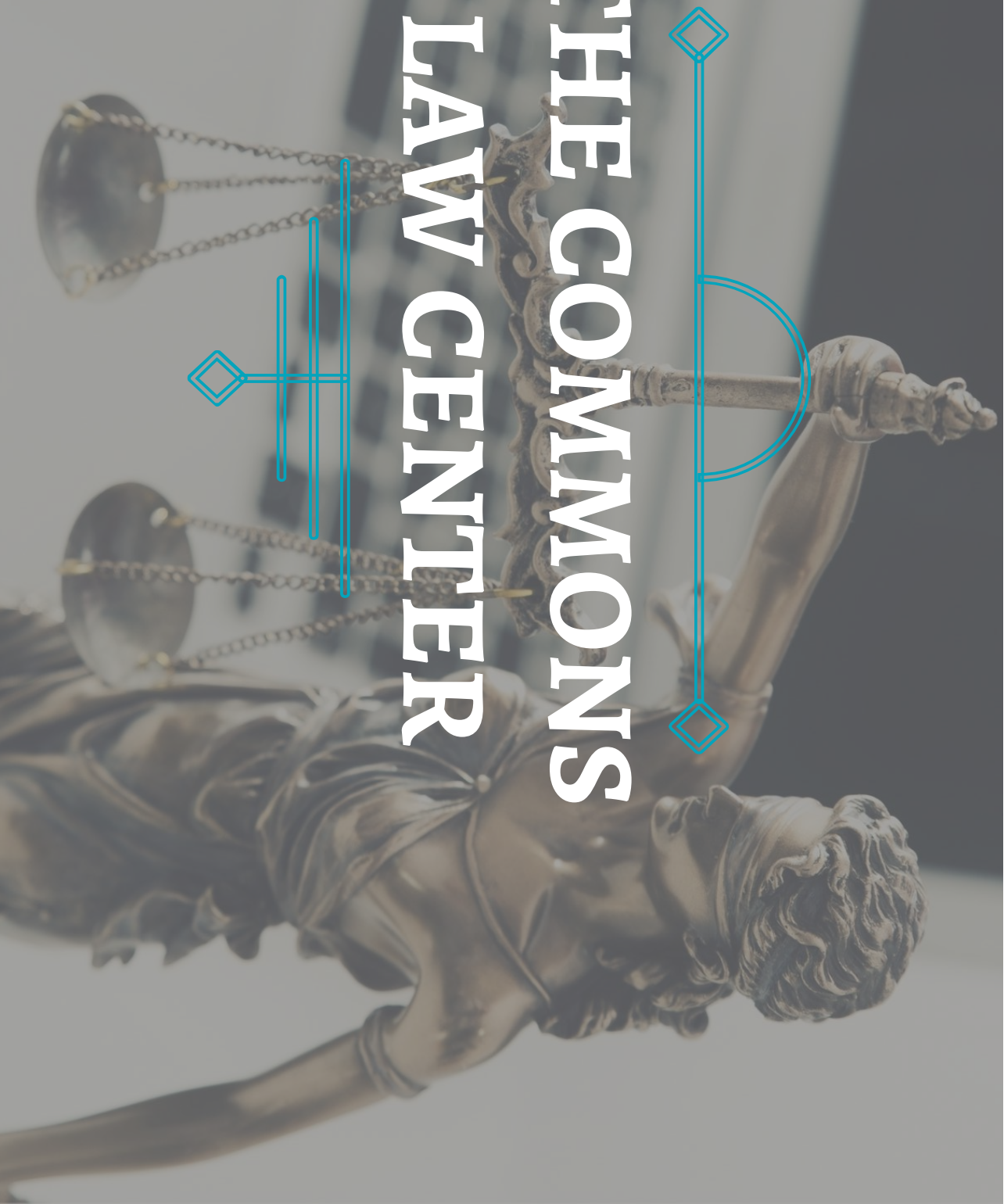
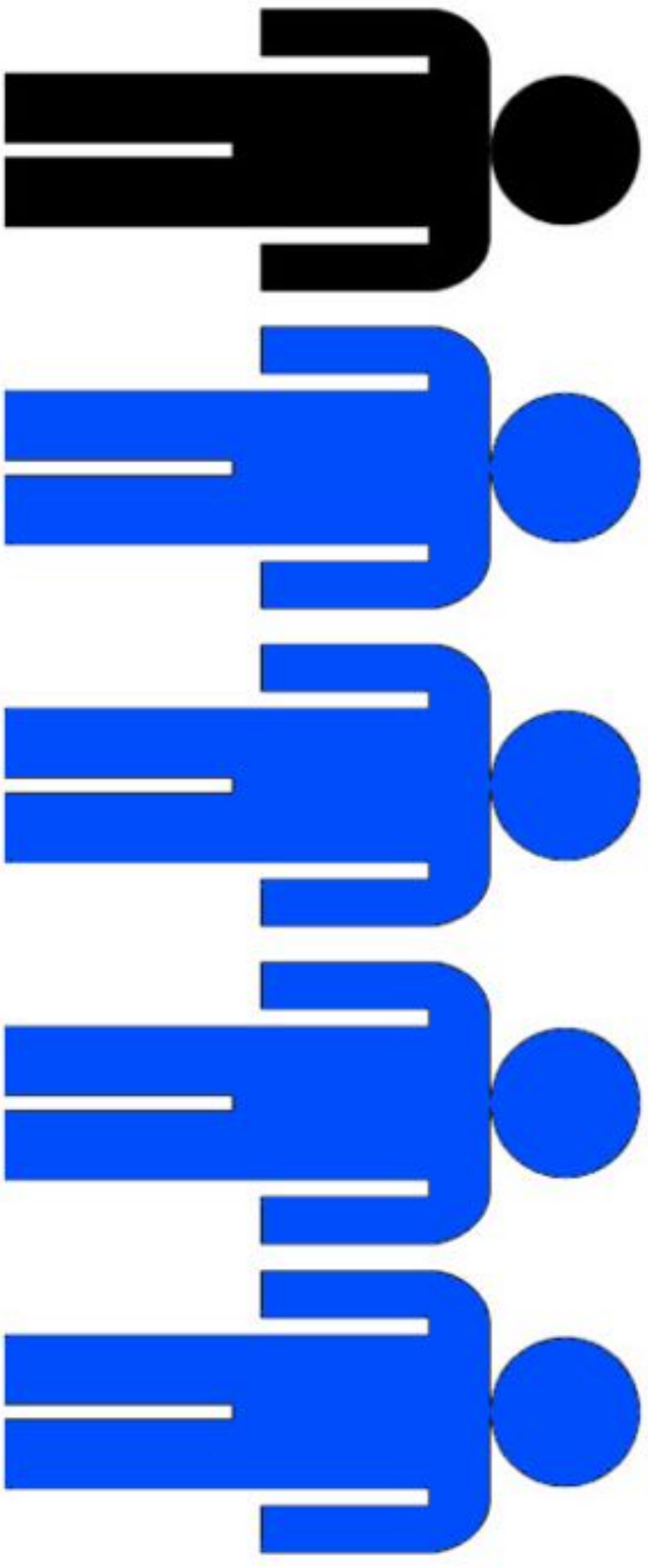

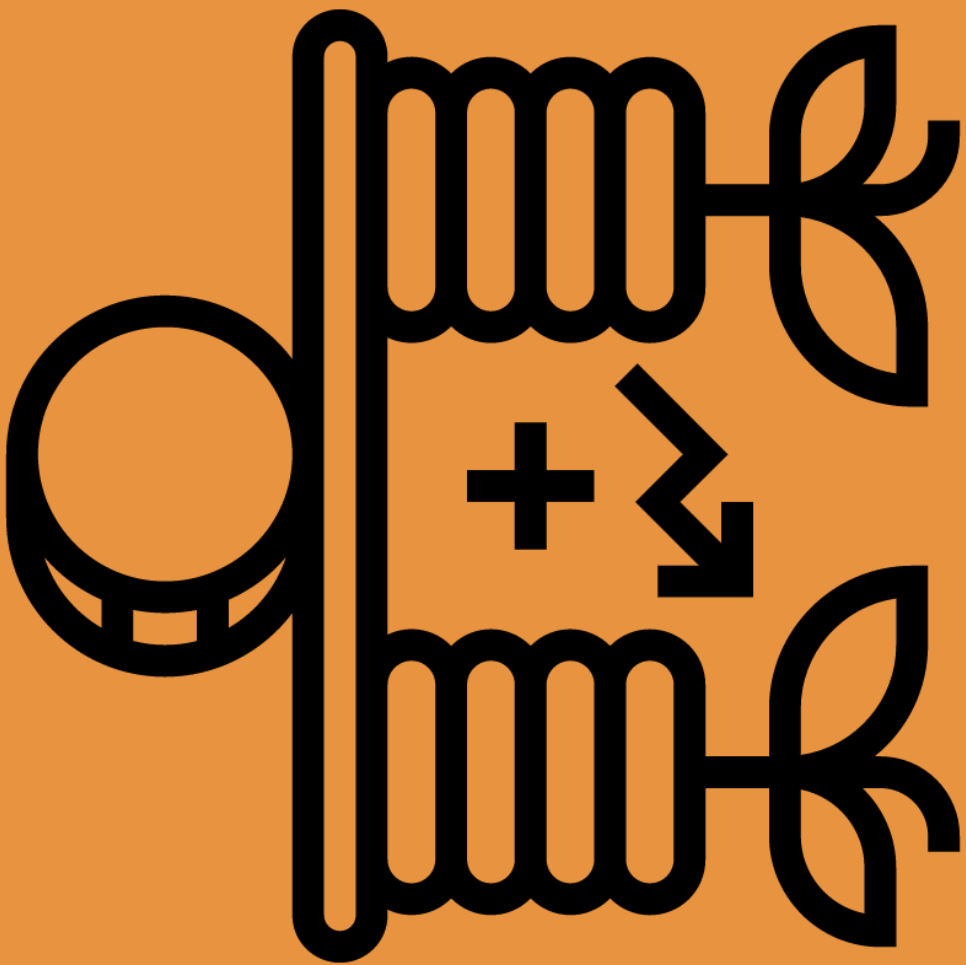

Eviction





- Women are most likely to face eviction
- University of Washington found Black and Latinx tenants 7X more likely to be evicted
- Oregon's homelessness rate is 3.5X the national average
- Last year 8% of Oregon tenants had lawyers



Legal services
prevent eviction
80% of the time.

Connecticut, Maryland,
and Washington all
enacted statewide right
to counsel for low income
tenants facing eviction.

Eligibility	Tenants are likely eligible if they receive a form of public benefits (TANF, SNAP, OHP)	Tenants are likely eligible if they qualified for rental payment help from Multnomah County	Over 50% of Oregonians qualify for services, including those who receive a form of public benefits
