Washington County is seeking applications to develop new transitional housing for households who face significant barriers to accessing and retaining permanent housing.

Offers up to **\$30,000,000** in capital funding from Metro Supportive Housing Services Funds for the acquisition, rehabilitation, conversion and/or construction of transitional housing units.

Proposed projects must include a <u>minimum</u> of 20 **new** beds, beds cannot be existing temporary housing capacity (i.e. shelter, existing transitional housing).

Transitional Housing definition: Time-limited housing with supportive services to provide households experiencing homelessness with interim stability and support to successfully move to and maintain permanent housing. Transitional housing programs cover housing costs and accompanying supportive services for program participants for a specific period, typically up to 24 months.

Transitional Housing Eligible Models NOFO will support:

Recovery-oriented

transitional housing
programs provide an
alcohol and drug free
living environment for
participants in active
recovery (e.g. exiting inpatient treatment or
engaged in outpatient
treatment) who are
seeking a recovery housing
environment.

Stabilization transitional housing programs utilizes a harm reduction approach for participants not in active recovery with unaddressed mental health and/or substance use disorder conditions.
