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McKinney-Vento Program: High-Level Overview

Student Identification – We can not serve who we do not identify. Identify barriers and remove them.

Equity – How do we address/ensure an equitable approach is taken to identifying and addressing barriers for MV students.

Outcomes – What are your goals in relationship to non-McKinney-Vento students? How is data being used to identify areas to improve the outcomes of MV students and how is data informing efforts, initiatives, and strategies.



McKinney-Vento Strategic Planning

A ***Needs Assessment*** can provide identify areas of strengths and areas that need improvement.

Developing a ***Project Action Plan*** that is data-informed can help integrate and align resources to remove the unique barriers encountered by McKinney-Vento students.

The ***Coordination of Services*** can identify, people, institutions, or groups you will/may seek collaboration to provide services to students in your district

McKinney-Vento ***Training*** can facilitation basic awareness and knowledge of McKinney-Vento and ensure institutional knowledge is school, district, and ESD wide.



In Conclusion:

A strong McKinney-Vento Program will be grounded in data, have clearly articulated goals, and identified coordinate services to support youth experiencing homelessness

A strong McKinney-Vento Program will have examples of strategies and initiatives that have worked, potential areas of improvement, and new approaches to serving youth experiencing homelessness

A strong McKinney-Vento Program will share perspectives of barriers and challenges faced by youth experiencing homelessness with articulated or proposed solutions.
