The Education Reengagement Program provides education and employment support services for young people in Washington County ages 14–24 who have been disconnected from school.

Whether you're in traditional high school, taking GED classes or preparing for college or the workforce, we can help you gain the confidence required to reach your goals.

### SERVICES INCLUDE:

- Tutoring
- Test preparation
- Financial assistance to cover education-related costs (GED prep courses, school supplies, etc.)
- Incentives for reaching educational goals
- One-on-one mentoring and support to help you succeed in your classes
- College prep guidance and goal planning for the future

- Connections to short-term financial assistance for housing applications, rent, utilities, and move-in costs
