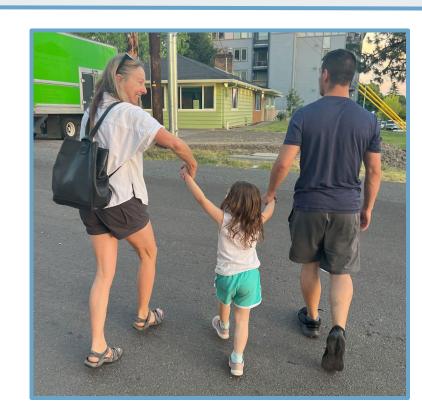




- Serving clients since 2019
- 40 Staff: 14 program staff, 15 shelter support staff, and 2 eviction prevention staff
- 70 room shelter in Tigard
- Dedicated eviction prevention services

## **ESG Homeless Prevention Program**

- FPTV receives a referral from Community Connect through HMIS
- Clients can be eligible for:
  - Short Term rental assistance
  - Medium term rental assistance
  - Rental and Utility arrears only
  - Relocation assistance



# **ESG Homeless Prevention Program**



#### The Case Manager:

- Confirms eligibility
- Conducts an occupancy assessment and habitability inspection
- Confirms that the unit does not exceed FMR
- Assists with housing navigation
- Collects a W-9 from the property manager
- Re-verification every 3 months
- Ongoing stabilization case management

## **ESG Activity Summary**

- Our service target was 86 households
- 25 total HHs have received funds
- 8 HHs "on their own"
- 4 income'd out: >30% income, but unable to pay
- 3 exited



## **ESG Performance Standards and Objectives**

**HUD: Performance Objective** - Decent housing and affordability

• Decent housing achievable, affordability, not

**HUD: Performance Standards** - Reduction in new incidences, reduced return, remaining housed after 6 months

Most households required support for the full eligibility period

**Opening Doors:** Improve access to mainstream services

• Resource referrals, warm handoffs, bi-lingual support

## **ESG Performance Standards and Objectives**



#### A Road Home: Prevent homelessness

 For the households served, for the duration of the funding

Consolidated Plan: Provide rental support, provide housing navigation and case management, provide supportive services.

- Housing navigation most utilized when HH had eviction notices
- Referrals included both HH enrolled and those not eligible for ESG
