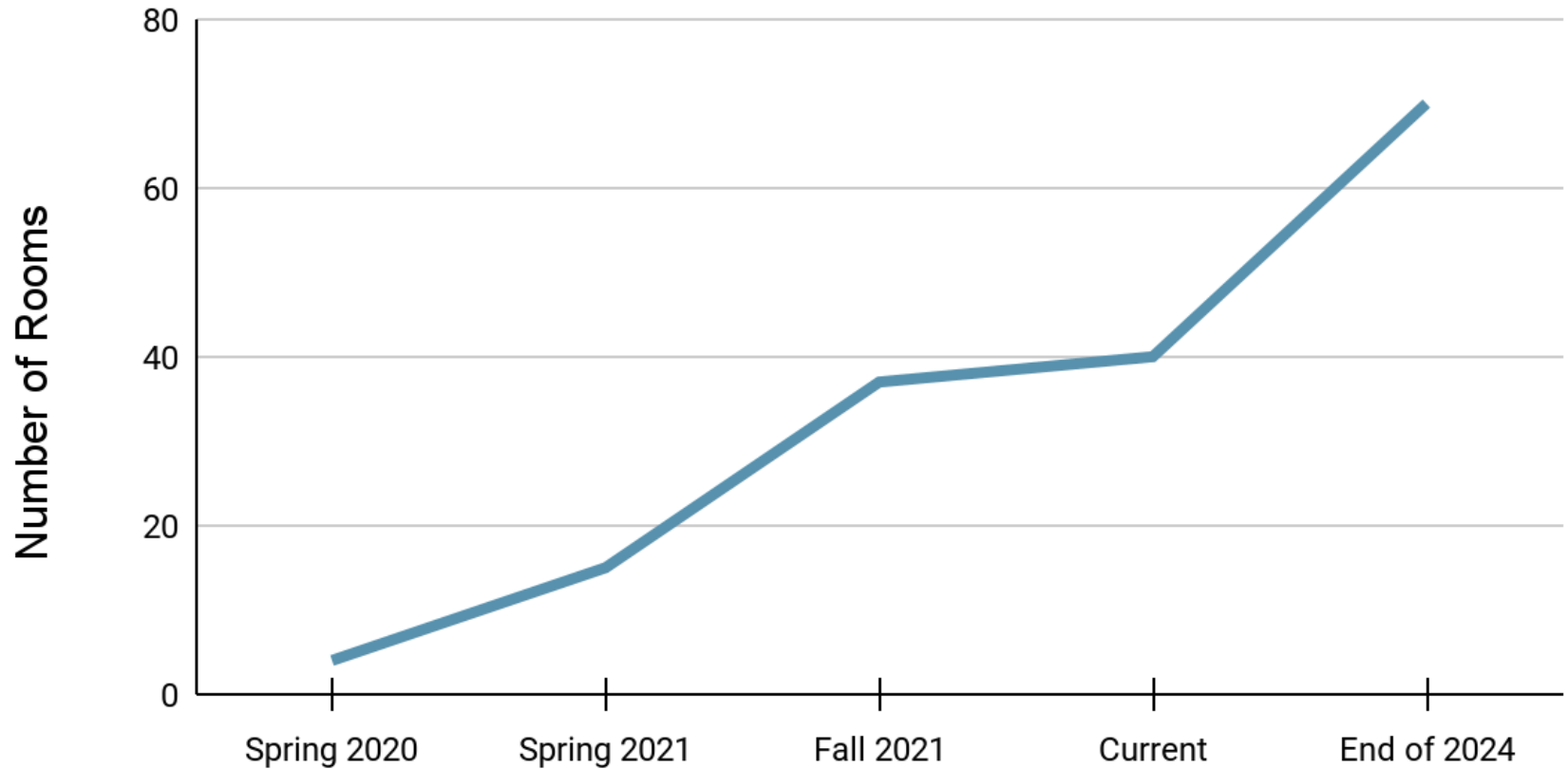

Enrichment Programs

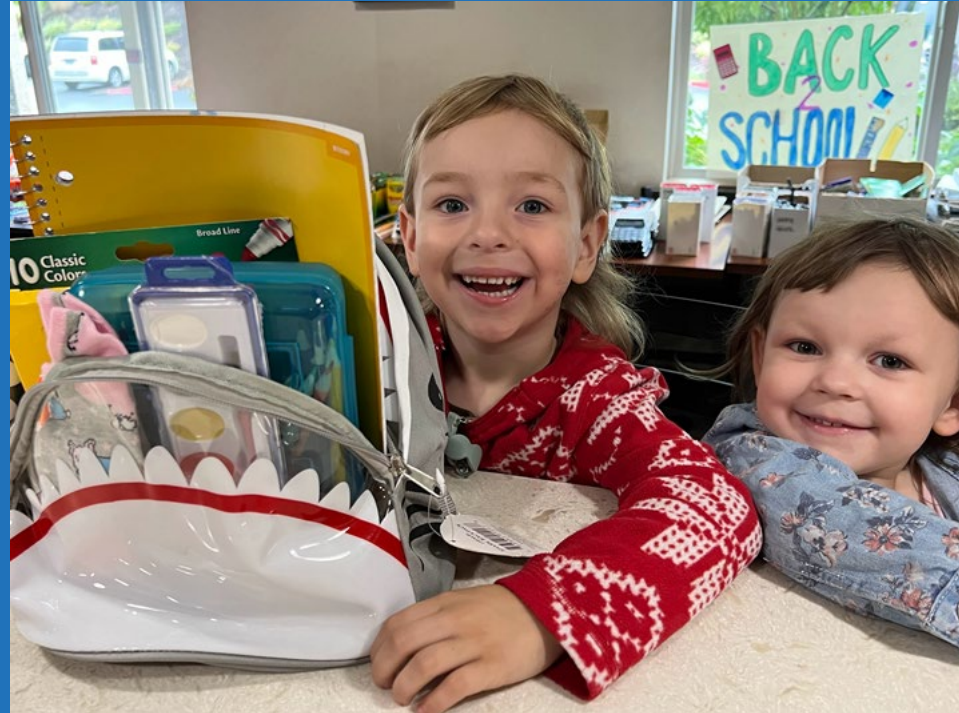
