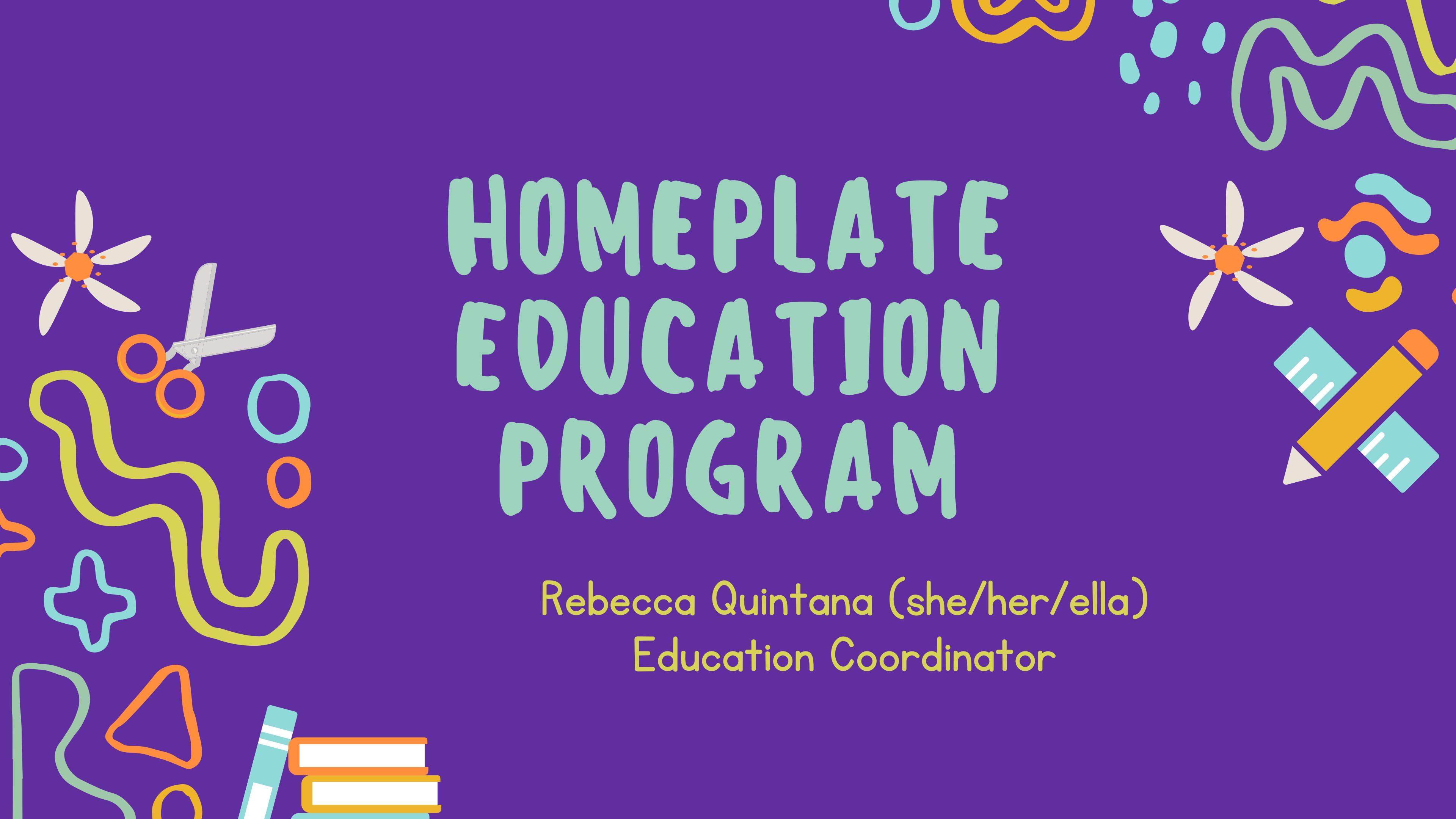

HOMEPLATE EDUCATION PROGRAM

The HomePlate Education Program focuses on providing access to school reconnection, navigating financial aid, enrolling in college or trade schools, and providing Life Skills classes for youth experiencing homelessness or housing instability. We work with youth ages 12-24. Currently our Education Department is a team of one (me).

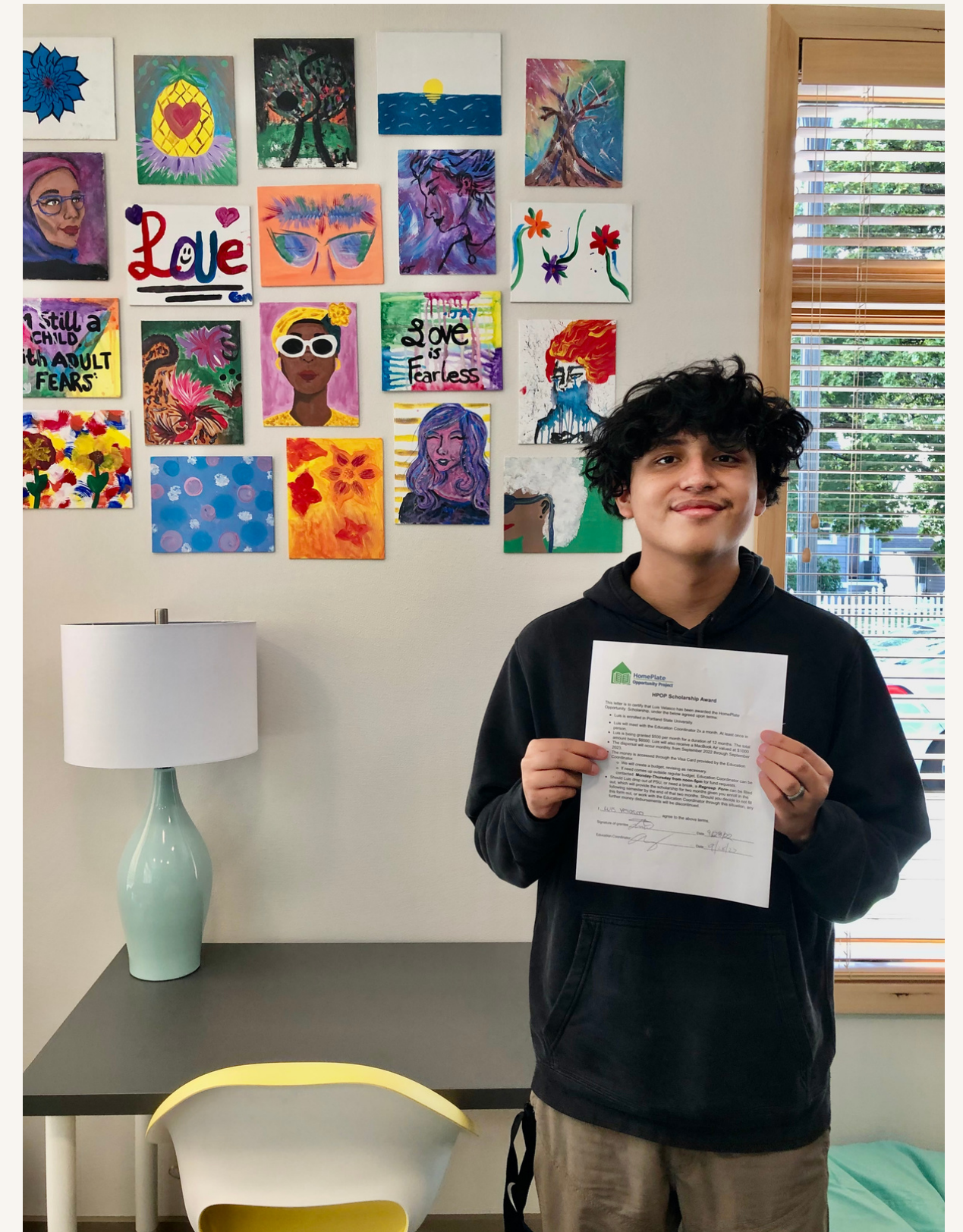

YOUTH EDUCATION SCHOLARSHIP (YES)

There are a limited number of scholarships we give out per year for underserved communities. The goal of the scholarships is to eliminate as many financially based barriers as we can so youth can transition their lives back to going to school.

Specifics: 18-24 years old, Washington County specific, covers university/college/vocational programs. Monthly stipend disbursement.



SPANISH GED PROGRAM

Youth can apply to receive support funds for 6 months (2 PCC terms), while they work on getting their GED.

Help with enrollment

Pay for all classes, registration cost, pre-tests and testing.

Youth receive monthly stipend to support them while taking classes

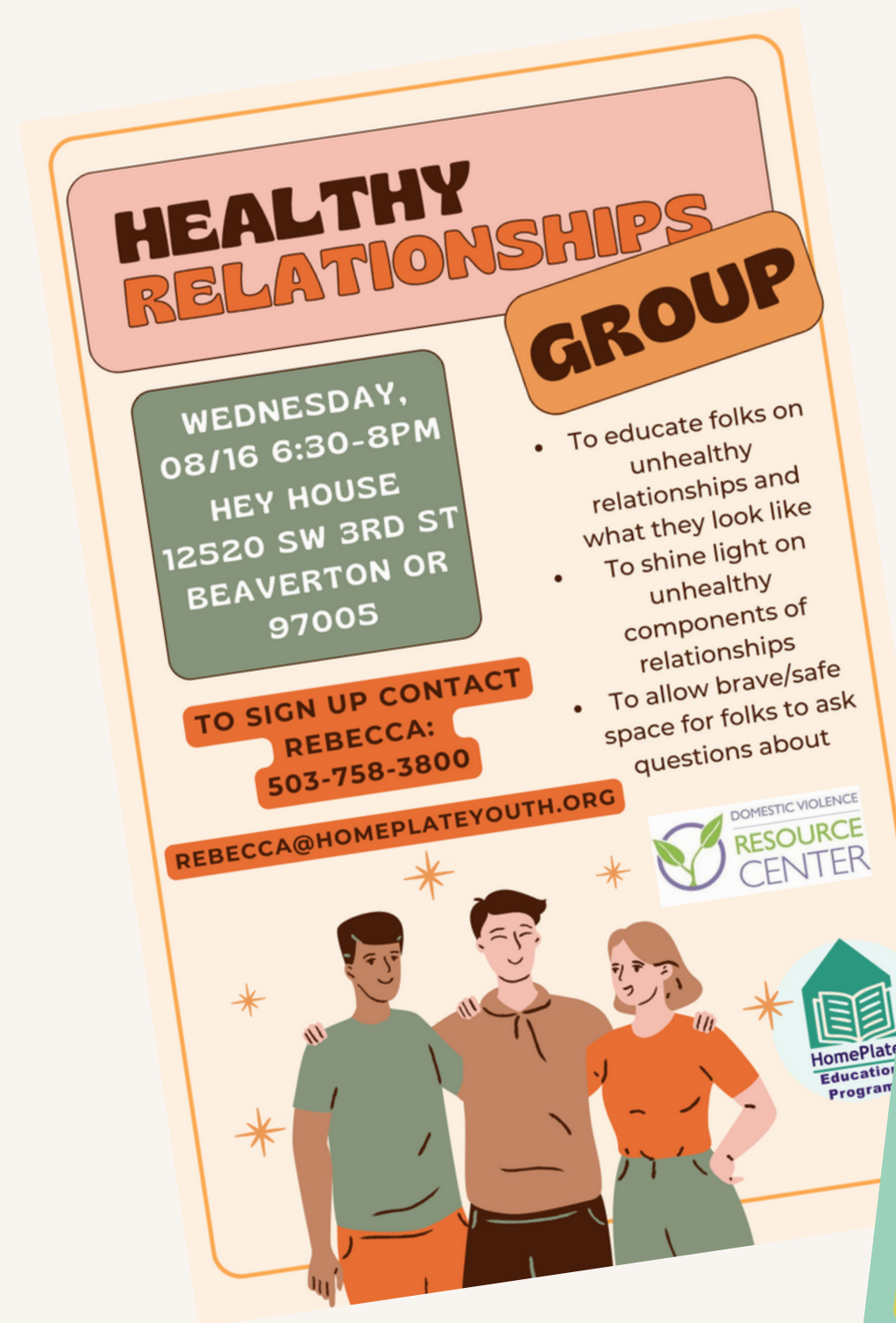
Youth can receive laptop through us as well.
