Improvements for Walking & Biking

Tigard and Washington County have partnered to bring new sidewalks, bike lanes, lighting and drainage facilities to SW 121st Avenue between Tippitt Place and Whistlers Loop.

Why is this project needed?

This project is identified in Tigard's Transportation System Plan (TSP) 2035 as a high-priority to improve safety for all road users including pedestrians, bicyclists, and drivers. Tigard's TSP guides the development and implementation of projects to complete our transportation system. Similarly, Tigard's Complete Street Policy, adopted in June of 2019, provides high-level policy support for this project and others like it to build facilities that work well for all road users.

Currently, SW 121st Avenue, between Tippitt Place and Whistlers Loop in the city of Tigard, has two travel lanes, limited street lighting, no bike lanes, intermittent sidewalks, and inadequate drainage facilities. This section of 121st Avenue is adjacent to densely populated residential neighborhoods.

What is the solution?

This project will improve safety and traffic flow on 121st Avenue with:

- Continuous sidewalks
- Bicycle facilities
- Street lighting
- Drainage facilities

A 24-inch water main will also be installed. Tigard's approach of replacing pipelines in coordination with other construction projects is part of the city's commitment to maintaining affordability for customers. This coordination will lower the cost of the water project and minimize road and traffic impacts.
