## How the system works:

**A.M. SERVICE:** The morning route is serviced twice per day beginning at the Vernonia City Hall, this line travels to Hillsboro , stopping at central business, school, and shopping areas, including a stop in Banks, and ending at Willow Creek Transit Center .

**P.M. SERVICE:** The afternoon route runs twice per day , beginning at 4:30 p.m. and ending back at Vernonia City Hall at 6:22 p.m.



## Tips for Riding the Bus

- Please be at your stop 5 minutes early to help us better service you and others.
- You can also flag the bus down at any location titled “Flag Stop”. If you plan to catch the bus one of these stops, please call our office so the driver can be alerted to look for you.
- **Please be ready to pay your fare when you board, with exact cash or a ticket. Drivers do not carry change.**
- Service animals are the responsibility of the owner and must be on a leash or in a carrier at all times.
- Max of 5 carry-on items allowed.

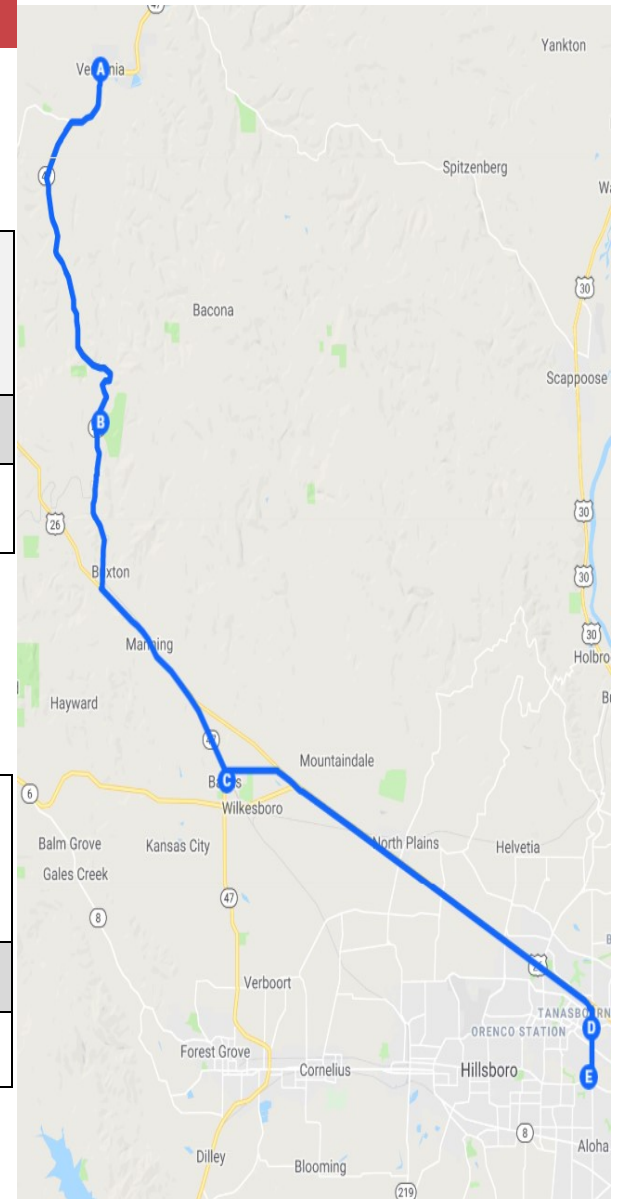
**Transit Route Map**
