Project Location

NW Cornell Road, between NW 102nd Avenue and NW 113th Avenue

Project Goals

- Widen Cornell Road from two lanes to three lanes (one travel lane in each direction and a center turn lane)
- Improve safety and capacity for all travel modes, including continuous raised cycle tracks and sidewalks on both sides of the road

Project Elements

- Dedicated left-turn lanes on Cornell Road at 107th Avenue and Cedar Mill Elementary School
- Signalize the intersection of Cornell Road and 107th Avenue
- Roadway geometry improvements
- Street lighting
- Storm drainage upgrades

Funding

- Project Budget is \$6.8 million – including engineering, right-of-way, and construction
- Funded through phase 3d of the Major Streets Transportation Improvement Program (MSTIP)
