

Walker Road – Phase 2 Schendel Avenue to Butner Road

PROJECT FACT SHEET

Project Location:

Walker Road from Schendel Avenue to Butner Road

Roadway Information:

- Classification: Arterial
- Posted Speed: 45 mph (speed limit will not change)
- Design Speed: 45 mph
- Daily Traffic Volumes: 17,000 - 24,000 vehicles/day (current)
- Daily Traffic Volumes: 33,000 - 38,000 vehicles/day (forecasted)

Project Goals:

- Consistent roadway cross-section throughout corridor
- Continuous bike and pedestrian facilities
- Construction of a portion of the Westside Trail (along THPRD frontage)
- Improved road geometry and sight distance
- Design with the future development of the area in mind
- Utility and water quality improvements

Project Funding:

The project is funded through a combination of Phase 3d of the County's Major Streets Transportation Improvement Program (MSTIP) and Traffic Development Taxes (TDT). Project budget is \$7.1 million for engineering design, right-of-way acquisition, and construction.

Project Schedule:

Final roadway design: thru Spring 2019

Right-of-Way acquisition: thru Winter 2018

Construction: Spring 2019 thru Fall 2020
