- Sign Background: "Green" , Sign Legend & Border: "White"
No Prefixes Or Suffixes & Meet MUTCD Retroreflectivity Standards
- Size: Varies x 24"
- Letters: (Street Name) 6" Series C - Initial Upper Case/Lower Case
Superscript For Numerical Streets: 3" Series C In All Lowercase Letters
If Street Name(s) Is (Are) Longer Than The Next Signal Text , Use Series B
- Letters: (Next Signal) 4" Series C - All Upper Case
- For Intersections Where Each Leg Has a Separate Name, The Name Of The Street To the Left Shall Be Displayed On The Left And Separated From The Road On The Right Name With A "/" i.e.: Kaiser / 143rd
- Typically Installed In Advance Of Turn Lanes At Signalized Intersections.
- Required For All New Signal Installations & Modifications Of Existing Signals On Arterial Roads Excluding Private Access Signals and Pedestrian Only Signals.
