The template test produced by staff will comply with [Section 430-37.2 G \(1\)\(a\)](#) and will be centered on the subject tract, and if a rectangular template is allowed under subsections (i)/(ii) it will be aligned to the maximum extent possible with a road or stream (if applicable) abutting the site. The resulting test does not imply land development approval or a land use decision. The burden of proof is on the applicant to gather documents/evidence necessary to determine if the approval standards are met. To obtain a County decision that a site meets the template dwelling approval standards, an applicant must submit to the County Planning office a land use application and fees along with the template test and documentation to address all approval standards. Customers are advised to schedule a pre-application meeting with County staff to receive detailed information on the approval standards and application requirements.
