Transportation Projects Bid Process

Most of Washington County's road/street improvement projects are built by construction contractors selected though a competitive bid process. Oregon law requires us to select contracts over \$250,000 through this process.



We prepare a bid solicitation package describing the scope of work, contractor responsibilities and our expectations.



We advertise the bid solicitation on the OpenGov Procurement website for two to four weeks.



On the bid opening date, all the bids received on time are opened, read aloud and recorded on OpenGov. Bid openings are currently online only.

We review the lowest bid to make sure it meets all requirements.



After a seven–day notice period, we ask the Washington County Board of Commissioners to award the contract.
