21	In these consolidated appeals, petitioner and intervenor-petitioners
22	challenge two county board of commissioners' decisions. LUBA No. 2024-006
23	is an appeal of "An Ordinance Amending the Transportation System Plan
24	Element of the Comprehensive Plan Relating to the Extension of Tile Flat Road"
25	(the Ordinance). LUBA No. 2024-007 is an appeal of "Resolution and Order No.
26	24-9" (the Resolution). The Resolution contains findings supporting the
27	Ordinance.
28	MOTION TO INTERVENE
29	On February 29, 2024, the City of Tigard filed separate motions to
30	intervene on the side of petitioner in LUBA No. 2024-006 and LUBA No. 2024-

- 1 007, but included only one filing fee of \$100 with both of its motions. On March
- 2 7, 2024, we issued an order requiring the City of Tigard to transmit to LUBA
- 3 within seven days a second \$100 filing fee, or LUBA would deny the motion to
- 4 intervene in LUBA No. 2024-007. OAR 661-010-0050(3). On March 13, 2024,
- 5 the City of Tigard transmitted a second \$100 filing fee. The City of Tigard's
- 6 motions to intervene in LUBA Nos. 2024-006 and 2024-007 are granted.

- 8 On March 15, 2024, LUBA received the record transmittal in these
- 9 consolidated appeals. On March 28, 2024, petitioner filed objections to the
- 10 record. On April 4, 2024, the county filed a response to petitioner's objections,
- along with an amended record table of contents. The amended record table of
- 12 contents satisfies petitioner's objections.

BRIEFING SCHEDULE

- The record is settled as of the date of this order. In these consolidated
- 15 appeals, petitioner shall submit a single petition for review, intervenor-petitioner
- 16 Steele shall submit a single intervenor-petitioner's brief, intervenor-petitioners
- 17 Andrea D'Amico, Randy Campbell, Lillian Stone, and John Stone shall submit a
- 18 single intervenor-petitioner's brief, and intervenor-petitioner City of Tigard shall
- 19 submit a single intervenor-petitioner's brief. The petition for review and
- 20 intervenor-petitioners' briefs are due 21 days after the date of this order. We
- 21 encourage petitioner and intervenor-petitioners to coordinate their briefing in
- order to avoid repetitive and overlapping arguments. Respondent shall submit a

- single respondent's brief which shall be limited to 15,000 words unless 1 permission for a longer brief is given by the Board. OAR 661-010-0035(2). 2
- Respondent's brief shall be due 42 days after the date of this order. The final 3

opinion and order shall be due 77 days after the date of this order. 4
