

The Council Creek Regional Trail, a long-term vision in Washington County, is becoming a reality.

Neighboring communities are excited about the benefits of this new pathway, including:

- Car-free travel, reducing climate impact and lowering transportation costs for all
- An alternative to TV Highway ideal for people of all ages and abilities—for fun, fitness, getting to work, running errands or catching a bus or MAX
- A feature for business districts and neighborhoods along the trail

Washington County continues to work with partners to:

- Transfer the abandoned rail corridor from ODOT to a local partner so it continues to provide a public benefit as a multiuse pathway for people to bike, hike and stroll and preserving the corridor for an eventual extension of high-capacity transit into Forest Grove.
- Create agreements that shift maintenance responsibility from ODOT to Washington County and adjacent cities
- Finalize the design of the trail and enhanced roadway crossings (planned to be complete in 2025)
- Build the trail (planned to start in 2026 and be complete in 2028)
