Commissioner of the Month Commissioner Jerry Willey

This month we welcome Commissioner Jerry Willey who represents District 4, a large portion of the rural area of Washington County including Banks, North Plains, Forest Grove, Cornelius and Gaston. In addition to sharing his thoughts, he will provide an update on the Rural Broadband initiative.

Jerry worked for 33 years as a CPA and partner in the firm of Jones & Roth, CPAs retiring in 2010. He was elected as the Hillsboro Mayor in 2009 and served 8 years. Jerry is a graduate of Washington State University with a Bachelor of Arts in Accounting. He spent 4 years in the Navy including a tour in Vietnam. Jerry believes in giving back to the community and has volunteered for many organizations. In 1997 he was recognized as Hillsboro Citizen of the Year by the Hillsboro Chamber of Commerce. He has also received a Mayors Leadership Award from the Oregon Mayors Association in 2015, a special merit award from the Hillsboro Chamber in 2016, and the James C. Richards Memorial Award from the League of Oregon Cities in 2016.
