SIDEWALK GAPS IN URBAN UNINCORPORATED WASHINGTON COUNTY

During the next Work Program period 2005-2007, Issue Paper 2016-01 (IP 2016-01), "Solutions for addressing Walkway Gaps in the Urban Unincorporated Area," will celebrate its 10-year anniversary. This issue paper examined the existing sources for financing gaps in the pedestrian infrastructure and identified, in Appendix A, additional financing tools.

Although in the years since issuance of IP 2016-01, pedestrian facilities have been constructed, many areas in the urban unincorporated county still are without safe walk areas for pedestrians. The upcoming LUT Work Program should include, as a Tier One priority, an evaluation of the solutions for addressing walkway gaps to determine if the existing tools are making progress in eliminating gaps in the pedestrian infrastructure during the past 10 years. Questions should be asked about whether more tools identified in Appendix A of IP 2016-01 should be implemented and/or if new tools for closing gaps should be considered.
