## **Main Agenda:**

### **TV Highway Transit and Development Project**

Bernadette Le from TriMet and Jason Nolin from Metro

- Project partners seeking to improve safety & travel on TV Hwy, building on may years of planning, moving toward a project with funding from FTA
- Line 57 potential replacement with a frequent service replacement
  - o Safety, Ridership, Improving Rider Experience, and Improving Travel Times
- Project benefits – upgrading all bus stops to stations (shelters, lighting, seating, real-time arrival info), buses running every 12 minutes
- Paired with enhanced crossings near each station, improved access for people with disabilities
- Collecting surveys on proposed stops through Oct 13
- Fewer stops (currently ¼ mile apart, this would be closer to 1/3 but with improved amenities to improve access to the stops). Project will also bring transit signal priority
- Working with ODOT on how the stations will be structured – will be pullouts like Murray/TV but not all stops will be pull-outs (the partial pull-outs will no longer be used as it contributes to confusion and crashes)
- Project will also improve dwell time – allowing all-door boarding and faster payment options
- Community questions about synchronizing signals on TV to improve traffic
