## PH Accreditation

- Measures a health department's performance against a set of nationally recognized, practice-focused and evidence-based standards.

## PH Modernization

- Serves as a framework and vision for how the division operates.
- Outlines the unique responsibilities and accountability metrics of governmental public health.
- Identifies a set of foundational areas that must be available in every community and the capabilities necessary to support the foundational areas.

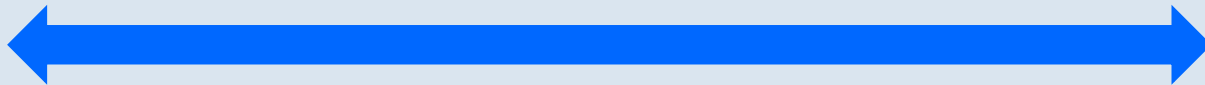
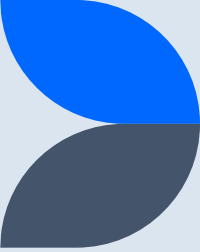

# Background/Context

16

- Washington County will be working over the next biennium to develop its local Modernization Implementation Plan (MIP)
- The MIP will outline how Washington County, as the local public health authority, will implement all the foundational capabilities and programs outlined by the state legislature
- This plan will be developed using feedback collected from internal and external stakeholders
