SAFETY PRESENTATIONS

Your safety is essential in an unpredictable world. Equip yourself with the skills to navigate your surroundings confidently. Listen to your intuition, stay alert, and learn the skills to feel safe.

- WCSO partners with you to teach you about personal, home, bike and water safety, and other crime prevention techniques, among other topics.
- These presentations can be geared towards youth and adults of all ages and are adjusted to fit your needs.
- Learn to identify concerns or suspicious activities and report them to 9-1-1 or the non-emergency line.

- Having an open dialogue about online safety as it is essential for children and adults alike.
- Avoiding online dangers, guidance for both adults and youth.

NEIGHBORHOOD WATCH/BUSINESS WATCH

Work with your neighbors to establish or revitalize this proven crime prevention program. Through this program, WCSO will partner with you to:

- Implement crime prevention techniques to make your neighborhood less attractive to criminals.
- Build community, working together.
- Identify when and how to report suspicious behaviors and crimes.
- Address your neighborhood concerns.

OLDER ADULT SAFETY AND SCAM PRESENTATIONS

Scams are an evolving and unfortunate concern for many. They can affect us online, over the phone, through mail, and sometimes even in person.

- Our Elder Safe program assists victims aged 65 and older through the criminal justice system. The program empowers older adults to stay vigilant by covering various topics, including scam prevention, signs of elder abuse, how to report a crime, and more.
- Find out how to identify scams and get informed about current and common scams circulating.
- What to do if you are a target of a scam and get help after falling victim to fraud.

- Precinct Tours: We invite groups of all kinds to visit and tour our facilities. Our tours walk visitors through many of our different yet essential work areas, including Patrol, Property and Evidence, Jail operations, and more.
